

PROPOSED UPDATE TO ARS 32-102

The BTR has more registered Home Inspectors than Geologists, Landscape Architects or Assayers. Yet Home Inspectors do not have a member on the Board.

This law should be changed:

- Out of fairness
- To give representation to Home Inspectors, who are the subject of nearly 50% of all the BTR's disciplinary actions
- To make the Board more representative of the BTR's registrants
- This change could take place on 6/30/2008 when the term of an appropriate Board member is set to expire.

ARS 32-102 - Board of technical registration

A. A state board of technical registration is established consisting of members appointed by the governor as follows:

1. Two architects.
2. ~~Three~~ Two professional engineers, ~~two~~ one of whom ~~are~~ is a representatives of a branches of engineering other than civil engineering and ~~are~~ is registered in ~~those that other~~ branches pursuant to this chapter.
3. One public member.
4. One landscape architect.
5. One geologist of assayer.
6. One land surveyor.
7. One home inspector.

B. Upon the expiration of any of the terms a successor, qualified pursuant to subsection A, shall be appointed for a full term of three years. The governor may remove a member of the board for misconduct, incapacity or neglect of duty. Appointment to fill a vacancy caused other than by expiration of term shall be for the unexpired portion of the term.

C. No member may serve more than two consecutive terms.
